Tech Tip

Devices vs. Speed

Have you stopped to consider how many devices are connected to the Internet in your home? If you have a smartphone, tablet, laptop and connected TV, that's four devices immediately using your bandwidth. Then, consider who else is in your home and how many connected devices they have...it quickly adds up. When you have multiple connected devices, you run the risk of slow Internet, which can lead to some problems, such as:

BUFFERING

"Buffering" refers to how long it takes for data to be retrieved or downloaded from a server which is particularly important when streaming video and audio.

- Netflix movies may take a long time to download, or the movie may stop playing while your connection buffers
- Youtube videos won't play, or they might pause in the middle
- Music may not play correctly
- Email attachments can take longer to download

DOWNLOADING


"Downloading" refers to data that is being received from a remote system to a local system. With slow downloading you may find:

- Images and graphics on web pages look blurry
- Web pages take longer to load
- You may experience buffering

Beware of Tech Support/PC Repair Scam

Reliance wants you to be on the lookout for this tech support scam.



We've discovered scam artists are using the phone to try and con you. Reliance Connects will never call you and ask you for your credit card information or ask you to pay for a PC repair or tech support service over the phone. If you get a call from someone claiming to be from "your local phone company or your tech support team" and they are trying to scare you with tactics like, you have viruses or malware on your computer, hang up! We would also encourage you to report this call to the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) at 1-877-FTC-HELP. Here are some tips from the FTC on what to look for, what to do if you get a call and what to do if you think you've been scammed.

- Don't give them remote access to your computer and then make changes to your settings that could leave your computer vulnerable.
- Don't let them, install anything on your computer, like malware, that could steal sensitive data such as user names and passwords.
- Don't give control of your computer to a third party who calls you out of the blue.
- Never provide your credit card or financial information to someone who calls and claims to be from tech support.
- If a caller pressures you to buy a computer security product or says there is a subscription fee associated with the call, hang up. If you're concerned about your computer, call your security software company directly and ask for help.
- Update or download legitimate security software and scan your computer. Delete anything it identifies as a problem. Call your tech support team at Reliance Connects if you need assistance.
- If you paid for bogus services with a credit card, call your credit card provider and ask to reverse the charges. Check your statements for any other charges you didn't make, and ask to reverse those, too.
